Verbs and Nouns

Verbs

Appall

- To horrify, shock, overcome with fear
- Related Words:
 - ***Abash***: make ashamed or embarrassed
 - ***Petrify***: stiffen with fear (literally-turn to stone)



Discern

- To see clearly, perceive



Esteem

- To value highly, regard
- Related Words:
 - ***Homage***: active respect or reverence
 - ***Cherish***: to have affection and respect for something
 - ***Deference***: active respect or reverence



Feign

- To pretend
- Related Word:
 - *Feint: a pretended blow to mislead an opponent*



Meditate

- To think, reflect, intend, plan
- Related Words:
 - ***Deliberate***: consider various courses of action
 - ***Ponder***: weigh an idea thoughtfully
 - ***Ruminate***: reflect upon (implies going over a subject repeatedly)
 - ***Retrospection***: looking backward about what happened or would have happened



Obsess

- To haunt, beset, harass

Obsession n.

An image, thought, or influence which
continually fills or
troubles the mind;

a *compulsive interest*
or preoccupation,
seemingly beyond one's will to control.

- To become less severe, soften



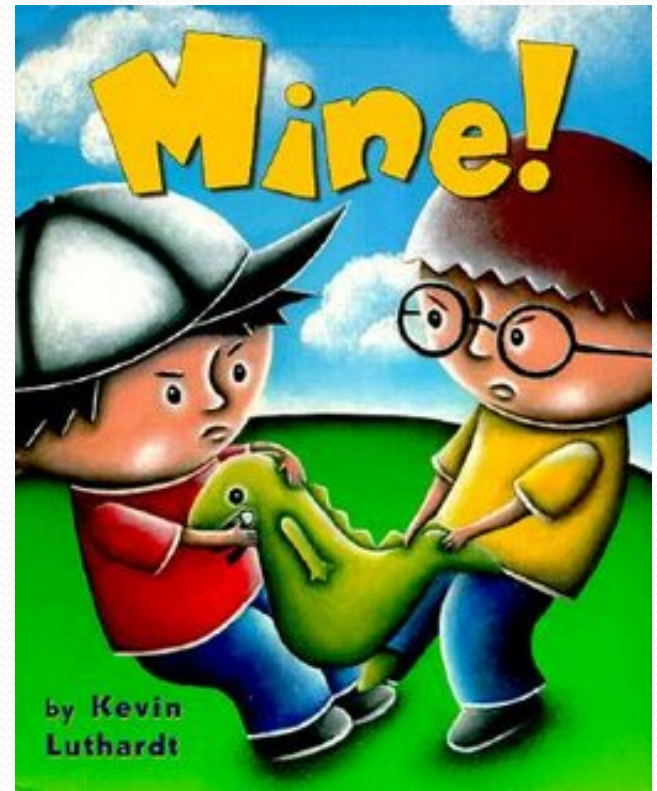
Salvage

Wrest

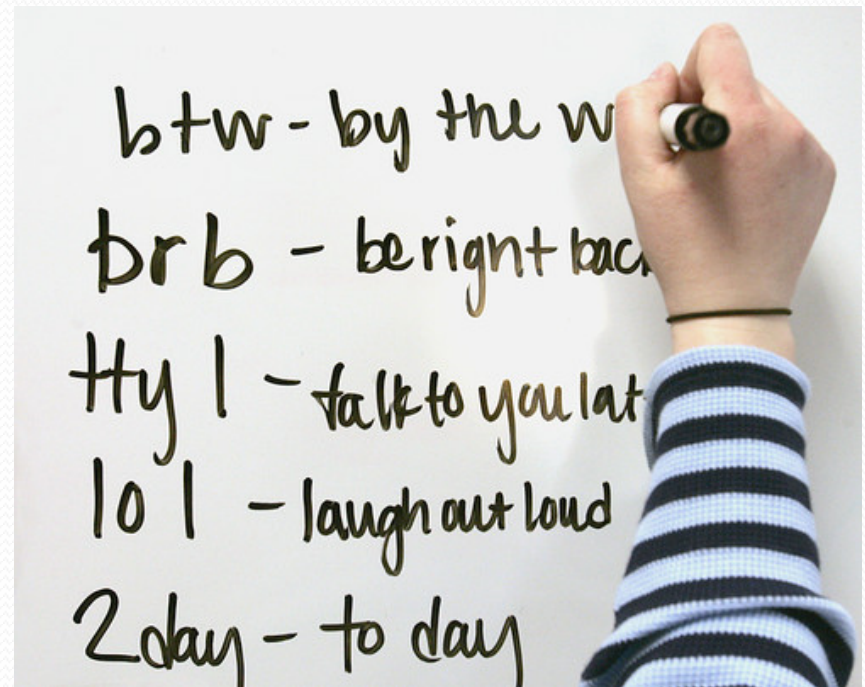
- To take by force, twist from

Brevity

- Shortness, conciseness
- Related Word:
 - *Abbreviate: to shorten*



Censure

- Strong criticism, condemnation
- Related Word:
 - ***Censorious***: to be harshly critical or faultfinding



Chaos

- Confusion, disorder
- Related Words:
 - ***Derangement:*** mental chaos
 - ***Disarray:*** mild chaos (like a dirty bedroom)
 - ***Bedlam:*** a noisy uproar
 - ***Pandemonium:*** (strongest chaos word): screaming disorder
 - ***Anarchy:*** political chaos marked by the absence of government



Citadel

- A fortress or stronghold
- Related Word:
 - ***Arsenal***: a factory or storage place for war material



Counsel

- Advise, shared knowledge; legal advisor
- Related Word:
 - **Council:** *is a group of people that makes decisions*



Celebrity

- A widely known person



Custody

- Keeping, care, guarding




Deluge

- A great downpour or flood
- Related Word:
 - ***Inundate: to flood (with questions, mail, etc.)***



Demeanor

- Conduct, behavior, manner
- Related Word:
 - ***Mien:*** (same meaning)
